Meals include <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lasagna: It's one of the ultimate one-pot meals — made of layers of vegetables, sauce, cheese, and sometimes meat, sandwiched between sheets of pasta, make for a dish.• Pasta salad: It is a dish prepared with one or more types of pasta, usually chilled, and most often tossed in a vinegar, oil or mayonnaise-based dressing, also served for lunch or supper.• Fried eggs or bacon with bread and tea or coffee or cornflakes.• Rice with beef/chicken or fish stew• Drinks: Only offer non-alcoholic drinks.
